I-405 Northbound—

1. Take Exit 20B (NE 124th St/Totem Lake Blvd Exit);
2. Stay to the right, follow the Totem Lake Blvd. Exit.
3. Proceed straight from the stop light, up the hill to NE 128th St.
4. Follow the signs to the parking garages.

I-405 Southbound

1. Take Exit 20, (NE 124th St.)
2. Turn left onto NE 124th St;
3. Take a left at Totem Lake Blvd/124th Avenue NE.
4. Proceed to 120th Ave NE and turn right
5. Go up the hill to NE 128th St.
6. Follow the signs to the parking garages.

**FREE PARKING
& Directions to Classroom**

Follow signs to the **Blue Entrance** and park in the **Blue Parking Garage**. Take the **Tan** elevator to the ground floor and follow the sidewalk to the entrance of the Evergreen Surgery and Physicians Center building. When you enter the building, you will be on the second floor. Take the elevator or stairs down to the first floor.

Resilience is the trait that will empower you. The development and use of resilience in the workplace is key. Resilience can be learned and is at the very core of extraordinary leadership.
